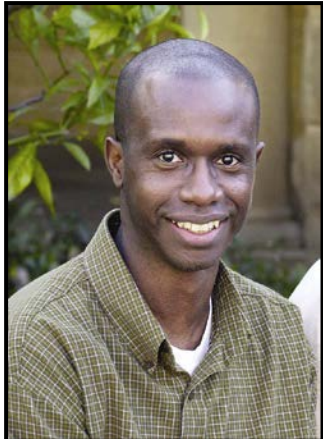
Every aspect of the graduate school process—including the why, how, where, when, and who—is discussed, as well as the process of conducting research and completing a doctorate.
