Listed below are scholarships that have been available in recent years. Amounts for individual awards typically range from \$250 to \$2500. Actual amounts for this year are subject to fund availability.

**Mechanical Engineering Endowment Scholarship** is a \$500 award for one ME student (seniors, juniors or graduate students are eligible) who have demonstrated his/her excellence in education. Special consideration will be given to students pursuing their senior project or masters project/thesis in areas related to fluid mechanics.

**David A. Brown Fellowship in Mechatronics** to promote the professional development of a junior, senior or graduate engineering student in the area of Mechatronics, who is a U.S. citizen, and advance the development of the Mechatronics program at SJSU. Recipients of this award are also expected to work as paid assistants in the Mechatronics Laboratory approximately seven hours per week during the fall and spring semesters in 2021-2022.

**Steven Meacham Memorial Scholarships** are two \$2500 scholarships in memory of ME student Steven Meacham, who was to graduate in Fall 2017. Students selected for this scholarship must be undergraduates eligible to take their senior design project classes next year. The selected student must complete a community-service oriented senior project in their ME 195A&B during academic year 2021-2022. The project will be assigned to the selected students by Dr. Jinny Rhee.

**Robert Dees Award:** Five \$1000 awards to promising and deserving ME undergraduate or graduate students.

**Francis Huang Memorial Scholarship Award** to deserving and promising ME students. The exact scholarship amount is yet to be determined.

All awardees are required to attend the ME scholarship award night on Thursday, May 13th, beginning at 7:00 PM. This will be a virtual event. Scholarship donors will be invited to this event as well as ME alumni.
