**This is your confirmation for your Sparta Camp overnight session on Tuesday, August 2 - Wednesday, August 3, 2022.**

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION - COVID VACCINATION RECORDS**

Our records show that your COVID-19 self-certification process is incomplete and you are **NOT** in compliance with the CSU COVID-19 Policy. **In order to attend your overnight Frosh Orientation, you must be up-to-date with your COVID-19 vaccination status. This requirement includes completing the COVID-19 vaccine primary series AND booster shot when eligible.** Your [COVID-19 self-certification form](#) in your MySJSU account must also be completed PRIOR to attending orientation.

If you have proof of your COVID vaccination card and your [vaccination record](#) has not been verified or is still under review, check-in at Student Wellness Center at 8:30 am on your orientation date to obtain a clearance pass to participate in Frosh Orientation. To maintain a safe environment for all students, students who have not yet satisfied COVID-19 vaccine requirements or whose exemption requests have not yet been approved **will not** be permitted entry. Please contact New Student and Family Programs to reschedule your session.

**Check-In:** Please arrive at **8:30am** and check in at the **Student Wellness Center, Room 122**. Once you are checked in at the Student Wellness Center, you may proceed to the check-in process for orientation. Orientation check-in will take place on the west side of the Spartan Recreation and Aquatic Center (SRAC) near the South 7th Street Garage in the D-3 section of this [map](#). **Check-in will begin at 9:00 am and will end at 10:30am.** Coffee and a continental breakfast will be provided from 9:00am-10:30am after you have checked-in. The program will start promptly at 10:30 am and conclude on day two, no later than 2:00 pm. Students who arrive late will not be permitted to attend the event, so please be on time!

\*Breakfast, lunch and dinner on day one, as well as breakfast and lunch on day two will be provided\*

Overnight housing accommodations will be provided to students. A pillow and blanket, two sheets, pillowcase, and towel/washcloth will be provided\*

**Directions and parking information:** Please [click here](#) to access the virtual parking permit valid only on the date of your Session. You will be cited if you do not complete the [steps found here](#). We recommend that you park in the [South \(7th Street\) Garage](#) located on the corner of S. 7th and San Salvador Streets (377 S 7th St, San Jose, CA 95112, United States). **Guests: All guests must be registered to attend Orientation.** The Parent & Family Orientation fee is \$90 per person. You may register a guest for orientation in your [nextsteps.sjsu.edu](https://nextsteps.sjsu.edu) portal. *If your session is less than 1 week away, please visit us at the Solutions Table during check-in on the morning of your session to register a guest.* Please note that space is limited, so we encourage you to register in advance of the program.

### **What to bring:**

- Your SJSU Student ID Number and password to register for classes on your MySJSU Student Portal
- Your Next Steps Reservation Receipt with the barcode
- One form of state issued photo identification (ID), such as a driver's license, passport or state ID card
- Laptop/tablet for course registration. Note: A smartphone will not suffice.
- Paper/writing instrument for note taking
- Water bottle

- Face mask and hand sanitizer
- Closed-toe shoes
- Personal toiletries needed to stay overnight (i.e. toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, body wash, change of clothes for day two, pajamas, deodorant, etc.)

**Before attending Orientation:**

- **Complete the [SJSU COVID-19 Symptom Check Tool](#) prior to being on campus for your orientation session.** Be prepared to show proof at check-in that you are symptom free or you are not in isolation or quarantine by taking a screenshot of the green check :



If you test positive or are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, **please stay home** and contact New Student and Family Programs at [Frosh-Orientation@sjsu.edu](mailto:Frosh-Orientation@sjsu.edu) to reschedule your orientation for a future date.

- Complete [Spartan Link](#) online pre-orientation - this must be completed prior to attending on-campus orientation. This contains valuable information about course registration that would be helpful to review ahead of course registration at orientation.
- Complete the Reflection on College Writing found on Canvas at <https://sjsu.instructure.com> - this must be completed by the dates indicated in the [Table of Reflection Deadlines](#). You will not be able to enroll in your writing course until the Reflection on College Writing is finished.
- Download the official app for San Jose State University, also known as the SAMMY app at <https://sjsu.campusapp.com>

**IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

**All in-person and hybrid courses with in-person meetings have a COVID-19 prerequisite.** Requirements of CSU COVID-19 vaccine policy **must be** satisfied prior to enrolling in an in-person/hybrid class. To satisfy this prerequisite, students must complete the COVID-19 self-certification form in their MySJSU account **and** provide supporting documentation where applicable. Students who are not compliant will **NOT** be able to enroll in their in-person/hybrid class.

All students must also be in compliance with COVID-19 vaccination policy prior to their first in-person activity (ie. housing, orientation, first in-person class).

Please allow 2-10 business days for your record to be processed and verified. If your COVID-19 vaccination record does not meet verification guidelines, you will be notified via secure messages in your Student Wellness Center patient portal to take further action or submit additional documents.

**Mask Policy:** Due to the recent rise in COVID-19 cases locally and in our region, we will continue to require that masks or face coverings be worn when indoors and when it is not possible to maintain social distancing outdoors.

**Please note that Sparta Camp is MANDATORY. Late arrivals and walk-ons will not be accommodated. You must participate in the entire program in order to have your Orientation hold removed. Failure to attend or complete the program will make you ineligible to register and attend SJSU.**

**If you do not attend your scheduled orientation, your admission will be withdrawn. In case of an emergency, you must contact us within 48 hours of the session for which you are registered, by calling 408-924-5972 or emailing [frosh-orientation@sjsu.edu](mailto:frosh-orientation@sjsu.edu). You must provide verifiable documentation to support your absence and this must be submitted (by email) no later than 48 hours after your session date. This is a strict deadline.**
