This is your confirmation for your Spartan Experience for Transfers Orientation Session on Tuesday, June 21, 2022.

Please bring your Next Steps Reservation Receipt with the barcode and one form of state issued photo identification (ID), such as a driver's license, passport, or state ID card in order to check in. Find your Reservation here: nextsteps.sjsu.edu.

Check-In: Please arrive at **7:30am** and check in at the **Student Wellness Center, Room 122**. Once you are checked in at the Student Wellness Center, you may proceed to the check-in process for orientation. Orientation check-in will take place on the west side of the Spartan Recreation and Aquatic Center (SRAC) near the South 7th Street Garage in the D-3 section of this [map](#). **Check-in will begin at 8:30 am and will end at 9:30am.** The program will start promptly at 9:30 am and conclude no later than 5:00 pm. Students who arrive late will not be permitted to attend the event, so please be on time!

You will be cited if you do not complete the [steps found here](#). We recommend that you park in the South (7th Street) Garage located on the corner of S. 7th and San Salvador Streets. What to bring:

- Your SJSU Student ID Number and password to register for classes on your MySJSU Student Portal
- Your Next Steps Reservation Receipt with the barcode
- One form of state issued photo identification (ID), such as a driver's license, passport or state ID card
- Laptop/tablet for course registration. Note: A smartphone will not suffice.
- Paper/writing instrument for note taking
- Water bottle
- Face mask and hand sanitizer
- Proof of negative COVID-19 test taken within 48 hours of your session

Before attending Orientation:

- Complete [Spartan Link](#) online pre-orientation - this must be completed prior to attending on-campus orientation. This contains valuable information about course registration that would be helpful to review ahead of course registration at orientation.
- Download the official app for San Jose State University, also known as the SAMMY app at sjsu.campusapp.com
- Follow the [SJSU COVID-19 Symptom Check Tool](#) prior to being on campus for your orientation session
- Take a PCR COVID-19 test within 48 hours of your session. If you test positive, please [report a case](#).

COVID-19 Vaccination Exemption Protocols: Our records indicate that you have received an approved vaccination exemption. Due to your status, please follow the following instructions on the morning of your orientation session. **You must provide a negative PCR COVID-19 test taken within 48 hours of your session in order to attend orientation.** Please arrive at **7:30am** and check in at the **Student Wellness Center, Room 122**. Once you are checked in at the Student Wellness Center, you may proceed to the check-in process for orientation.

Additionally, due to the current surge in COVID-19 cases, we strongly encourage you to take a COVID-19 rapid antigen test on the morning of your orientation session. Rapid antigen tests can be ordered at www.covidtests.gov or you can contact your health insurance company to find out where to get free test kits. If you test positive with the PCR test or rapid antigen test, please stay home and contact New Student and Family Programs at transfer-orientation@sjsu.edu to reschedule your orientation for a future date.

Mask Policy: Due to the recent rise in COVID-19 cases locally and in our region, we will continue to require that masks or face coverings be worn when indoors and when it is not possible to maintain social distancing outdoors.

Guest Policy: We encourage you to attend SET Orientation individually, as guests will not be permitted to join you during any of the events happening during the day. Guests are invited to attend [Transfer Parent and Family Orientation](#) taking place virtually on June 22nd. You may register your guest(s) for Transfer Parent/Family Orientation on the [Summer 2022 Virtual Parent and Family Orientation Registration Google Form](#). The Google Form receipt is your guest's confirmation of registration. Your guest will receive a confirmation letter one week prior to their session with more information upon registering.

Please note that Transfer Orientation is MANDATORY. Late arrivals and walk-ons will not be accommodated. You must participate in the entire program in order to have your Orientation hold removed. Failure to attend or complete the program will make you ineligible to register and attend SJSU.

If you do not attend your scheduled orientation, your admission will be withdrawn. In case of an emergency, you must contact us within 48 hours of the session to which you are registered for, by calling 408-924-5972 or emailing transfer-orientation@sjsu.edu. You must provide verifiable documentation to support your absence and this must be submitted (by email) no later than 48 hours after your session date. This is a strict deadline.
