Please note that Spring Orientation is MANDATORY. Late arrivals and walk-ons will not be accommodated. You must participate in the entire program in order to have your Orientation hold removed. Failure to attend or complete the program will make you ineligible to register and attend SJSU.

In case of an emergency, you must contact us within 24 hours of the orientation session at 408-924-5972. You must provide verifiable documentation to support your absence and this must be submitted (by email) no later than 24 hours after your session date. This is a strict deadline.

If you do not attend your scheduled orientation, your admission will be withdrawn.
