Greetings Incoming Spartan!

This is your confirmation letter for your two-day, overnight frosh orientation session for **Sparta Camp Session 1 on Monday, June 26 - Tuesday, June 27, 2023.**

Please bring your Next Steps Reservation Receipt with the barcode and one form of state issued photo identification (ID), such as a driver's license, passport, or state ID card in order to check in. Find your Reservation here: nextsteps.sjsu.edu.

Check In:

Check-in for orientation will take place on the west side of the Spartan Recreation and Aquatic Center (SRAC) near the South 7th Street Garage in the D-3 section of this [map](#).

Check-in will begin at 9:00 am and will end at 10:30am.

Coffee and a continental breakfast will be provided from 9:00am-10:30am after you have checked-in. The program will start promptly at 10:30 am and conclude on day two, no later than 5:00 pm. Students who arrive late will not be permitted to attend the event, so please be on time!

**Breakfast, lunch and dinner on day one, as well as breakfast and lunch on day two will be provided. Overnight housing accommodations will be provided to students. A pillow and blanket, two sheets, pillowcase, and towel/washcloth will be provided.*

We recommend that you park in the [South \(7th Street\) Garage](#) located on the corner of S. 7th and San Salvador Streets (377 S 7th St, San Jose, CA 95112, United States). Guests:

All guests must be registered to attend Parent and Family Orientation.

The Parent & Family Orientation fee is \$90 per person. Your guest may register by visiting the [Parent and Family Portal](#). If your session is less than 1 week away, please visit us at the Solutions Table during check-in on the morning of your session to register a guest. Please note that space is limited, so we encourage you to register in advance of the program.

What to Bring:

- Your SJSU Student ID Number and password to register for classes on your MySJSU Student Portal
- Your Next Steps Reservation Receipt with the barcode
- One form of state issued photo identification (ID), such as a driver's license, passport or state ID card
- Laptop/tablet for course registration. Note: A smartphone will not suffice.
- Paper/writing instrument for note taking
- Water bottle
- Face masks and hand sanitizer recommended
- Closed toe shoes and comfortable clothing for night activities
- Personal toiletries needed to stay overnight (i.e. toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, body wash, change of clothes for day two, pajamas, deodorant, etc.). Bed sheets, a towel, a washcloth and a pillow will be provided.

Before Attending Orientation:

- Complete [Spartan Link](#) online pre-orientation - this must be completed prior to attending on-campus orientation. This contains valuable information about course registration that would be helpful to review ahead of course registration at orientation.
- Complete the Reflection on College Writing found on Canvas at <https://sjsu.instructure.com> - this must be completed by the dates indicated in the [Table of Reflection Deadlines](#). You will not be able to enroll in your writing course until the Reflection on College Writing is finished.
- Download the official app for San Jose State University, also known as the SAMMY app at <https://sjsu.campusapp.com>

Student Immunization Requirements:

All incoming students who are aged 18 or younger prior to the start of the semester are required to have Hepatitis B vaccination, per [CSU Vaccination Policy](#).

As of May 1, 2023, the Bivalent mRNA COVID-19 vaccine is recommended for most students, per the [CSU Vaccination Policy](#). The vaccine is required for all students who reside in University Housing or those who have traveled or lived outside the U.S. for more than 30 days. You will not be required to show proof of a COVID-19 vaccination to attend your orientation session. You may find the most updated status of the immunization policy here:

Additional immunization requirements for students residing in University Housing and those who have lived outside the US for more than 30 days include:

- Meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY)
- Complete tuberculosis screening form

Masking Guidelines:

SJSU is a mask-friendly campus. The campus community continues to support those who choose to mask in our indoor spaces. Beginning June 1, 2023, mask wearing will not be required in the Student Wellness Center unless a student presents with upper respiratory symptoms when entering for an appointment.

Please note that Sparta Camp is MANDATORY. Late arrivals and walk-ons will not be accommodated. You must participate in the entire program in order to have your Orientation hold removed. Failure to attend or complete the program will make you ineligible to register and attend SJSU.

If you do not attend your scheduled orientation, your admission will be withdrawn. In case of an emergency, you must contact us within 48 hours of the session for which you are registered, by calling 408-924-5972 or emailing frosh-orientation@sjsu.edu. You must provide verifiable documentation to support your absence and this must be submitted (by email) no later than 48 hours after your session date. This is a strict deadline.
