Check In:

Please bring your Next Steps Reservation Receipt with the barcode in order to check in. Find your reservation here: nextsteps.sjsu.edu.

Check-in will take place on the west side of the Spartan Recreation and Aquatic Center (SRAC) near the South 7th Street Garage in the D-3 section of this [map](#).

Check In will begin at 8:30 AM (PST) and will end at 10:00 AM (PST).

Coffee and continental breakfast will be provided from 9:00 AM - 10:30AM after you have checked in. The program will start promptly at 10:30 AM (PST) on Day 1 and conclude no later than 5:00 PM (PST) on Day 2. Students who arrive late will not be permitted to attend the event, so please be on time! What do I bring to Sparta Camp?

- Your SJSU Student ID Number and password to register for Fall 2024 courses
- Your Next Steps Reservation Receipt with the barcode to check in
- One form of state issued photo identification (ID)
- Official transcript recommended
- Laptop/tablet for course registration. Note: A smartphone will not suffice.
- Paper/writing instrument for note taking
- A refillable water bottle
- Athletic attire, optional swimwear and closed toe shoes
- An additional outfit for the second day of Sparta Camp
- Personal toiletries needed for your overnight stay (ex. toothpaste, hair care, body wash, sleepwear, etc.)

*Bed linen, a towel, washcloth and pillow will be provided during your overnight stay
Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner on Day 1 and Breakfast & Lunch on Day 2 is provided.*
