**Anna Lambourne was a member of the SJSU Chapter of Phi Kappa Phi when she was a student here. She received a BA with honors in Russian and French in 1974 at the age of 58. Ms. Lambourne left a bequeath to our chapter when she passed away in 2017 at the age of 101.**

**The Executive Board has decided to award a \$2000 scholarship in her name to a student initiated at the spring induction ceremony. Ms. Lambourne’s interests included music, democracy, world travel art of all types, and education.**

**In honor of Ms. Lambourne’s devotion to life-long learning, this scholarship will be awarded to a “returning” student. A returning student is defined as a student who started or continued his or her education after a break of several years or more.**

**The scholarship will be applied toward student fees for the following year. Half of the money will be applied to each of the fall and spring semesters. Therefore, the recipient must be enrolled for the entire 2020 – 2021 academic year.**

**To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must complete all of the following by March 27, 2020:**

- 1. Join Phi Kappa Phi as directed in the invitation no later than March 24, 2020.**
- 2. Submit a one-page personal statement addressing why your earlier educational plans were interrupted, what motivated you to return and what your objectives are.**
- 3. Provide a copy of your unofficial transcript to show that you meet the definition of a returning student.**

**Your personal statement is limited to one page, single-spaced and in 12-point font.**
