

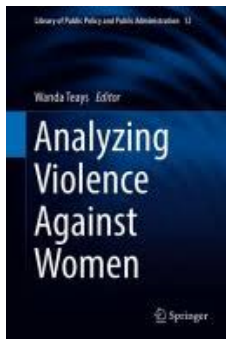
Philosophy and Feminism
