

A Day at the California Capitol!

Join faculty and students for an exciting day at the California Capitol!

- Step into the arena of high-level politics and public policy by traveling to Sacramento for a full day with legislators, lobbyists, and others “in the know”.
- The day will be hosted by the SJSU Department of Political Science and led by former Assembly Speaker pro tempore and SJSU Lecturer Fred Keeley and Professor Garrick Percival.
- The day will include a round trip bus ride, a “behind the scenes” tour of the Capitol’s centers of power and decision-making, and interaction with key members of the legislature.

Cost for the trip is \$15 per person (non-refundable) with the remaining portion subsidized by the Department of Political Science. **The cost for the trip must be paid at the time you sign up. No exceptions.**

The bus will depart San Jose State University at 6:30 A.M. sharp at the corner of 10th Street and San Antonio (right along-side the Business Tower) and leave the Capitol at 3:30 P.M., with a scheduled arrival in San Jose no later than 6:00 P.M.
