Alumni Scholarship: award amount: \$1,500*

The Alumni Scholarship is funded by generous donations from our graduates and is available to all Political Science majors. Applicants for the Alumni Scholarship must be full-time Political Science majors taking a minimum of 12 units.

Burton R. Brazil Scholarship: award amount: \$1,000 - \$1,500*

The Burton R. Brazil scholarship is funded by an endowment created by the family, friends and colleagues of Burt Brazil, a respected professor of political science who specialized in political theory and public administration and who served as Executive Vice President for SJSU. Applicants must be full-time students, either graduate or undergraduate, majoring in political science or public administration, with a strong academic record and a commitment to a career in public service or teaching.

Applicants must submit a short statement on their career goals and how the scholarship will assist them in their studies

John Gilbert Scholarship for International Studies: \$2,000 - \$4,000*

The John Gilbert Scholarship is exclusively for students who participate in a study abroad program. Applicants for the John Gilbert Scholarship for International Studies must be Political Science majors in an SJSU approved study abroad program with a GPA of 3.0 or above. Students with applications for international study pending are eligible to apply. Applicants must be full-time Political Science majors taking a minimum of 12 units.

Applicants must submit a short statement on the relevance of study abroad to the achievement of their educational and professional goals.

Steve Glickman Scholarship: award amount: \$1000*

This Scholarship honors Steve Glickman, who was deeply involved in local politics, and in public service on behalf of young people. Applicants must be equivalent of full-time undergraduate students, majoring in Political Science, with a commitment to a career in public service. Students planning careers in local politics or government are strongly encouraged to apply. Recipients will be selected by a committee comprised of faculty of the Political Science Department. The committee will consider the student's academic performance as well as the student's potential for engagement in public service at the local level.

Applicants must submit a typed, double-spaced essay of up to 500 words on "The importance of public service for local politics." Please note your essay will not be returned.

Wesley "Bud" Hubbard Scholarship: award Amount: \$1,500*

The Wesley "Bud" Hubbard Scholarship is named for a long-time local political leader and is for students interested in state or local government and politics. Applicants must be full-time Political Science majors taking a minimum of 12 units.

Applicants must also submit a typed, double-spaced essay of up to 500 words on "Why I Am Interested in Public Service." Please note your essay will not be returned.

Fauneil J. Rinn Scholarship: award amount: \$1,250*

The Fauneil J. Rinn Scholarship honors the late Professor Fanny Rinn and commemorates her advocacy of the advancement of women. Applicants must be women majoring in political science or public administration (MPA). A minimum 3.0 GPA is required. (Please Note: This fund is administered by the Community Foundation of Silicon Valley.)

Applicants must also submit the following: 1) a current resume and 2) a 500 word essay on a subject relevant to the political or governmental role of women

Charles Kunsman Scholarship: award amount: \$1,250*

The Charles Kunsman Scholarship was created by former students of this popular professor with the support of his colleagues and family. Professor Kunsman is fondly recalled for his personal warmth, humor and love of teaching comparative politics, given color by anecdotes from his extensive travels. Applicants must be full time undergraduate political science majors with a GPA of 3.0 or above.

Douglass McIntyre Award: award amount: \$1,250*

The Douglas McIntyre Award was established by the family of this life-long public servant and is open to all Political Science majors. The scholarship is awarded on the basis of academic performance and need. Applicants must be full-time Political Science majors taking a minimum of 12 units and must be eligible for financial aid at SJSU.
