2. Students should attend an SJSU Study Abroad informational meeting or individual counseling session with a Study Abroad advisor. In either case, students must obtain a signature from the advisor. 3. Students should prepare and submit an application to a recognized international study program through the SJSU Study Abroad office. That application, or proof of admission, should be attached here.
4. Applicants should submit a 500-word statement on the relevance of study abroad to their educational and professional goals, including a tentative budget for the overseas stay.
5. Applicants should have their complete application signed by the Gilbert Scholarship Advisor, Professor Karthika Sasikumar. A scanned copy of the application with her signature may be emailed to the Department (elizabeth.harding@sjsu.edu) in lieu of personal submission.
