### **Alumni Scholarship: award amount: \$1,500\***

The Alumni Scholarship is funded by generous donations from our graduates and is available to all Political Science majors. Applicants for the Alumni Scholarship must be full-time Political Science majors taking a minimum of 12 units.

### **Burton R. Brazil Scholarship: award amount: \$1,000 - \$1,500\***

The Burton R. Brazil scholarship is funded by an endowment created by the family, friends and colleagues of Burt Brazil, a respected professor of political science who specialized in political theory and public administration and who served as Executive Vice President for SJSU. Applicants must be full-time students, either graduate or undergraduate, majoring in political science or public administration, with a strong academic record and a commitment to a career in public service or teaching.

Applicants must submit a short statement on their career goals and how the scholarship will assist them in their studies.

### **Les Francis Scholarship for Civic Education: award amount: (\$2,500)**

This scholarship was created by Les Francis and endowed by Mr. Francis and his many friends, admirers, and fellow political consultants. The scholarship is intended to support prospective (or current) teachers of high school civics. Applicants must submit a letter of interest stating how the scholarship would assist their career in teaching, a writing sample (at least 3 pages in length), and an unofficial academic transcript. Awarded annually

### **Steve Glickman Scholarship: award amount: \$1000\***

This Scholarship honors Steve Glickman, who was deeply involved in local politics, and in public service on behalf of young people. Applicants must be equivalent of full-time undergraduate students, majoring in Political Science, with a commitment to a career in public service. Students planning careers in local politics or government are strongly encouraged to apply. Recipients will be selected by a committee comprised of faculty of the Political Science Department. The committee will consider the student's academic performance as well as the student's potential for engagement in public service at the local level.

Applicants must submit a typed, double-spaced essay of up to 500 words on "The importance of public service for local politics." Please note your essay will not be returned.

### **Wesley "Bud" Hubbard Scholarship: award amount: \$1,500\***

The Wesley "Bud" Hubbard Scholarship is named for a long-time local political leader and is for students interested in state or local government and politics. Applicants must be full-time Political Science majors taking a minimum of 12 units.

Applicants must also submit a typed, double-spaced essay of up to 500 words on "Why I Am Interested in Public Service?" Please note your essay will not be returned.

### **Fauneil J. Rinn Scholarship: award amount: \$1,250\***

The Fauneil J. Rinn Scholarship honors the late Professor Fanny Rinn and commemorates her advocacy of the advancement of women. Applicants must be women majoring in political science or public administration (MPA). A minimum 3.0 GPA is required. (Please Note: This fund is administered by the Community Foundation of Silicon Valley.)

Applicants must also submit the following: 1) a current resume and 2) a 500 word essay on a subject relevant to the political or governmental role of women. Please note your essay will not be returned.

### **Roy E. Young Scholarship: award amount: \$1,250\***

The Roy E. Young Scholarship was established by friends and former students of Roy E. Young in appreciation of his inspiring teaching and mentoring, and for his constant and enthusiastic interest in politics. This scholarship is designated for students who have taken at least two upper division courses in U.S. Politics.

Applicants must submit a short essay on a book or books about U.S. Politics that inspired them to pursue their major. Please note your essay will not be returned.
