I am pleased to announce that Stan Nosek has been appointed Interim Vice President of Finance and Administration and Chief Financial Officer. Stan begins his tenure at San José State effective February 1, 2025. The appointment will end on or before July 31, 2025. The process for naming a permanent Vice President will begin in February, once a selection committee has been established as prescribed by university policy.

Stan is a veteran of higher education leadership, including a 35-year career at UC Davis retiring as Vice Chancellor for Administration, and stints at Sonoma State and Cal Poly San Luis Obispo, where he most recently served as the Interim Vice President of Administration and Finance/CFO in 2024 and the Interim Vice President of Strategic Initiatives in 2023-24. In addition to his deep experience as a CFO, Stan brings leadership experience in the areas of housing, human resources, athletics, facilities and research. He also served as faculty at State University of New York - Cortland, led Western Association of College and University Business Officers (WACUBO) professional development programs at Stanford and UC Santa Barbara, and served as the board chair of the National Association of College and University Business Officers (NACUBO).

We are gratified to have a leader with Stan's breadth of experience serving in such an important transitional role for the University. Please help me to welcome Stan to campus over the coming weeks.
