

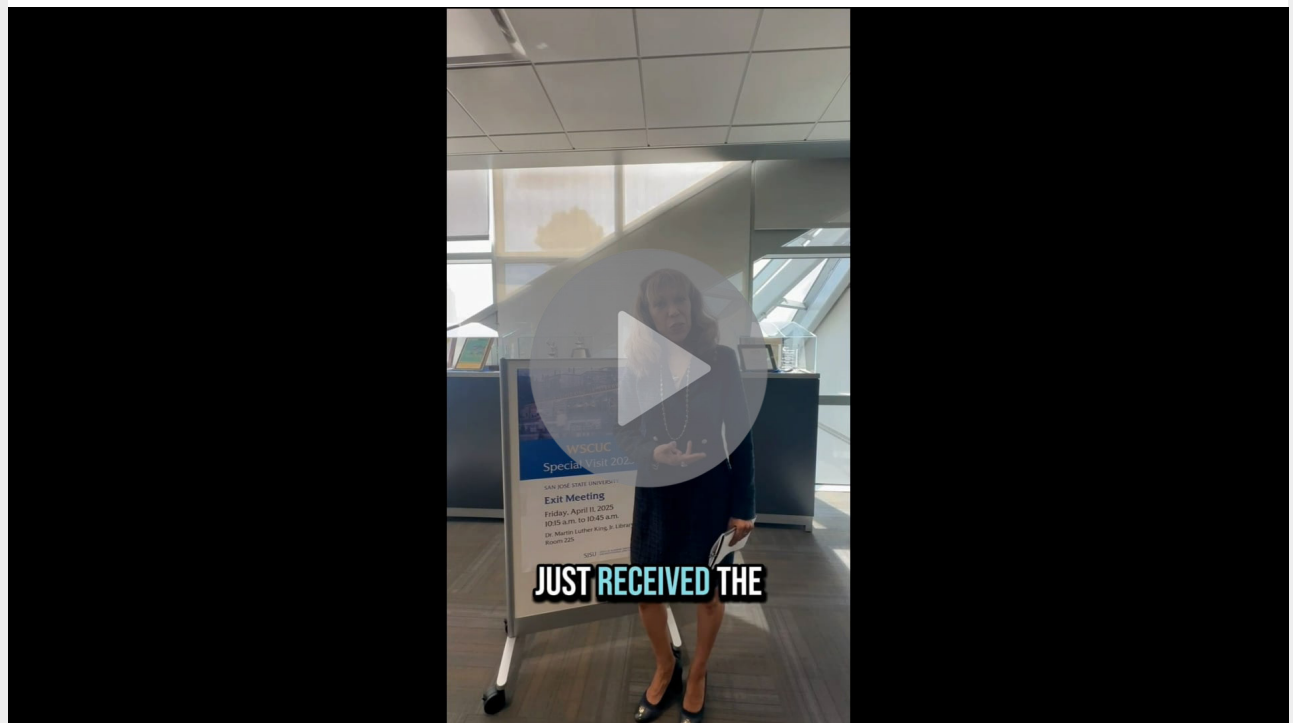

The team also provided thoughtful recommendations to guide our continued growth:

- *Build a common understanding of shared governance*
- *Carry out the campus climate survey plan and act on the findings*
- *Clarify and define roles and responsibilities for undergraduate advising and counseling*
- *Further integrate learning outcomes into academic planning processes*
- *Develop, fund, and implement a strategic plan for the Moss Landing Marine Laboratories*

We are proud of how our community came together throughout this process—sharing ideas, perspectives, and stories that reflect the strength of our academic

mission and our dedication to continuous improvement. We are especially grateful to those who helped lead the university’s preparation and engagement efforts.
