



Hello Spartans,

It's Election Day! **Today, November 4, is the last day to vote in this Statewide Special Election.** We encourage you to return your vote-by-mail ballot if you have not done so already.

You can return your vote-by-mail ballot

- by dropping it in the mail. Your ballot must be postmarked by today, November 4, and received by election officials no later than November 12.
- by dropping it in an official ballot drop box or at a vote center **no later than 8 p.m.** today, November 4.

There are three official ballot drop boxes on campus:

- Outside of the King Library: at the corner of San Fernando and Fourth Streets
- Outside DMH and ADM: along San Fernando Street
- Outside the Campus Village housing complex

[Find other official county drop boxes.](#) You can also drop off your vote-by-mail ballot at the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters located at 1555 Berger Drive, Building 2, San José, CA 95112, or at any vote center. [Find your closest county vote center.](#)

The closest vote center to SJSU for the Statewide Special Election is located at the [Olinder Community Center](#) Community Room. The address is 848 E William St, San José, CA 95116. The Olinder vote center is open today, **November 4**, from **7 a.m. to 8 p.m.** If you are in line by 8:00 p.m., you will be able to register and vote.

If you missed the October 20 voter registration deadline, you can still register to vote, in-person, using “same-day”, also known as conditional registration, at any vote center, including at the Olinder Community Center.
