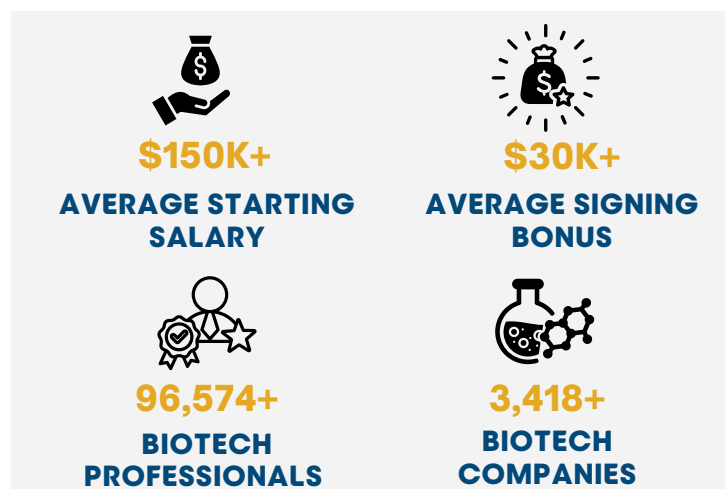
Study Biotechnology in the Bay Area



Requirements

-  US 4-year Bachelor's degree or equivalent, including biology, molecular biology, physiology, engineering, psychology, public health, zoology, chemistry and others.
-  GPA of 2.5 or higher in the last two years of university coursework.
-  General GRE-writing 4.0 (lower scores can be reviewed by the Directors).
-  Statement of purpose, resume and two letters of recommendation.
-  TOEFL 80 or IELTS 6.5 (for international students).
-  1+ years of work experience preferred.
