2 year plan for Transfer Students – No WST

This plan assumes that you are transferring with 60 semester hours, and have completed Core GE and American Institutions requirements. If you are transferring from a college on the quarter system, you may transfer to SJSU with fewer units, and you will need to take additional courses to complete the total of 120 units required for graduation. **This plan also assumes you did not yet pass the WST.**

As Psychology majors, we assume you have completed the lower division Psychology core at your community college (equivalent to Psyc 1, Stat 95 and Psyc 30) and the human biology supporting course (equivalent to Bio 21 or 65). If you have taken other Psychology courses at your community college, be sure to check with a Psychology advisor at SJSU to see if the course will be accepted towards the major. We also assume you have not yet started on your minor.

In the table below, the “year” refers to the year at SJSU. These roughly correspond to your Jr. and Sr. years. This planner assumes your minor will be 18 units.

Terms you need to know:

GE = General Education (SJSU Studies = Upper Division GE: Areas R, S, V and Z)

Open Elective = any course in the University, including Psychology

LD = Lower Division (Courses numbered 99 and below) All Community College courses are considered LD.

UD = Upper Division (Courses numbered 100 to 199)
