- 4) The student is to present this original signed and sealed *Minor Form* to their Major Advisor/Department for submission with their *Application for Graduation* (which will be submitted to the student services center).
- 5) Each student should keep their copy of the signed form for their personal files.
- 6) Changes to the courses originally listed on the application for graduation require a formal *substitution form*.
