Four Year Planner for Incoming Freshman Psychology Majors who desire to pursue the more research oriented Bachelor of Science degree rather than the Bachelor of Arts degree.

This plan assumes that you are transferring with 60 semester hours and have completed the Core GE and American Institutions requirements. We assume you have completed the lower division Psychology core at your community college (equivalent to SJSU Psyc 1, Stat 95 and Psyc 30) and the human biology supporting course (SJSU Biol 21 or 65 [not 65"o"] or a year of biology for biologists) You will need additional courses to complete the total of 120 units required for graduation. **We also assume you have passed the Writing Skills Test (WST) before your first semester at SJSU.** If you have taken other Psychology courses at your community college, be sure to check with a Psychology advisor at SJSU to see if the course will be accepted towards the major. We assume you do not have a minor.

In the table below, the "year" refers to the year at SJSU. These roughly correspond to your Jr. and Sr. years. You should file for graduation as soon as you have 90 units.

- LD = Lower Division (Courses numbered 99 and below)
- UD = Upper Division (Courses numbered 100 to 199)

* a year of Biology for biologists or Bio 65 (not 65"o") can be substituted for Bio 21 to meet psychology requirements.

** Stat 95 is a prerequisite to Psyc 100W. Psyc 100W is required as a prerequisite to Psyc 120 and 190.
