L.O.	Type(s) of assessment utilized (<i>rubric, survey, test, focus group, employee evaluations,, etc</i>)
After participating in a graduation workshop, students will demonstrate knowledge of the deadline and the requirements for the graduation application procedures by achieving a minimum of a 90% pass-rate on a post-event quiz.	Pre/post quizzes: The pre- and post- quizzes are essentially identical, with 9 graduation process questions and 1 self-assessment question. The post quiz includes an additional question about the overall benefit of the workshop.

**Although graduation workshops were presented in fall 2013, assessment was initiated in spring 2014.*

In spring 2014, 90 students participated in the Graduation 101 Workshops presented by the Graduation Team (GT). This is a decrease from the number of participants in fall 2013 (138). Of the total participants, 88 students completed the pre-quiz and 91 the post-quiz. Of the students who took the pre-quiz, 40% (4) achieved a pass rate of 89%. For the post-quiz, 36% (33) of students achieved the same pass rate.

Item analysis resulted in the following proposed changes for the fall 2014 workshop quizzes.

1. Questions #7 and #8 will be rephrased for clarity. ¹
2. Question #5 will be replaced by another question. ²
3. A presenter rating question will be added.
4. A comment section will be added.

Additionally, based on overall results, the pass rate and overall learning outcome will be reviewed for future semesters.
