Students with Dependents Self-Certification Guide

Early registration will be given to students who have any children/dependents under the age of 18 who receive more than half of their support from the student.

This guide illustrates the steps for the student to self-certify that they meet the criteria for this early registration appointment.

- 1. Login to MySJSU.
 - a. If you see the **Student With Dependents message**, click the <u>review and certify that you</u> <u>have at least one dependent</u> <u>under the age of 18</u> link and proceed to **Step 2**.
 - b. If you do not see the Student with Dependents message (shown above), go to the Personal Information section.
 - i. Click on the 3 Ellipses menu.
 - ii. Click the Dependents link.
- 2. On the Update Dependent Information:
 - a. Select **Yes** if you have a dependent that meets the criteria.
 - b. If yes is selected, enter the Date of Birth of the youngest dependent.
 - c. Check the Student
 Certification box to certify that the information provided is true and correct.
 - d. Click the button to submit your self-certification.
