Dr. Julia Gaudinski is Director of Research Development (RD). Prior to joining the Office of Research, Dr. Gaudinski served as an RD Specialist at University of California Santa Cruz and worked as a Senior Development and Grant writer at Climate Central. She also was President and Founder of Mobile Ranger, a science communication company designed to leverage mobile technology and reshape how people relate to the natural and human history of places. In addition, Dr. Gaudinski was a research affiliate at Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory and a postdoctoral researcher at University of California, Berkeley.

Dr. Gaudinski holds bachelor's degrees in Earth Science and Environmental Studies from the University of California, Santa Cruz, and a Ph.D. in Earth System Science from the University of California, Irvine. Her research expertise is in terrestrial carbon cycling particularly in forests and forest soils.
