Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	For in-network <a href="#">providers</a> \$6,950/person and \$13,900/family. For out-of-network <a href="#">providers</a> \$13,900/person and \$27,800/family.	See the Common Medical Events chart below for your costs for services this <a href="#">plan</a> covers. Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Yes, preventive care	This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. But a <a href="#">copayment</a> or <a href="#">coinsurance</a> may apply. For example, this <a href="#">plan</a> covers certain <a href="#">preventive services</a> without <a href="#">cost-sharing</a> and before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> . Are there other <a href="#">deductibles</a> for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet <a href="#">deductibles</a> for specific services.
What is the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> for this <a href="#">plan</a> ?	For in-network <a href="#">providers</a> \$6,950/person and \$13,900/family. For out-of-network <a href="#">providers</a> \$20,850/person and \$55,600/family.	The <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <a href="#">plan</a> , they have to meet their own <a href="#">out-of-pocket limits</a> until the overall family <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> has been met.
What is not included in the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> ?	Premiums, balance-billed charges, penalties, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> .
Will you pay less if you use a <a href="#">network provider</a> ?	Yes. See <a href="http://www.myhnas.com">www.myhnas.com</a> or call 1-877-356-0666 for a list of <a href="#">network providers</a> .	This <a href="#">plan</a> uses a <a href="#">provider network</a> . You will pay less if you use a <a href="#">provider</a> in the <a href="#">plan's network</a> . You will pay the most if you use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> , and you might receive a bill from a <a href="#">provider</a> for the difference between the <a href="#">provider's charge</a> and what your <a href="#">plan</a> pays ( <a href="#">balance billing</a> ). Be aware that your <a href="#">network provider</a> might use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <a href="#">provider</a> before you get services.
Do you need a <a href="#">referral</a> to see a <a href="#">specialist</a> ?	No.	You can see the <a href="#">specialist</a> you choose without a <a href="#">referral</a> .

**Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes**
