7 **Policy recommendation:**
8 **Amendment A to F14-1, Scheduling of Advance Registration and**
9 **Priority Registration**

10 Background: University Policy F14-1 ('Scheduling of Advance Registration and
11 Priority Registration') lists the groups of students who are eligible for priority
12 registration. Among the groups listed are Educational Opportunity Program
13 (EOP) students. Before mandatory orientation was instituted, EOP students
14 received priority registration for their first semester. Since the institution of
15 mandatory orientation, this is no longer the practice. The inclusion of the EOP
16 category in F14-1 has led to confusion, as EOP students were never granted
17 priority registration in subsequent semesters. In order to eliminate the confusion,
18 we propose to remove this category from the list of priority students.

19 **Resolved:** that EOP students be removed from Category A in F14-1.
