8 **POLICY RECOMMENDATION**
9 **Rescinds S67-31**
10 **Standards for Awarding Academic Credit: Faculty**
11 **Appointment at SJSU; Discipline Specific Expertise of**
12 **Faculty; Catalog Publication of Course**

15 Legislative History: S67-31 was adopted as of September 8, 1967 to identify criteria to
16 award academic credit for courses offered outside the regular college program. This
17 policy indicates “the course must be taught by an officially appointed member of the
18 College faculty”.

20 Rationale: This policy does not provide clear guidance on standards for awarding
21 academic credit and nor does it speak to the process used in the
22 appointment of a faculty member to SJSU. The policy title does not
23 accurately reflect the content in this policy. Furthermore, subsequent
24 policies have addressed the content identified in the title.

26 Whereas: The historical need that dictated processes defining courses for academic
27 credit no longer exists, and

29 Whereas: Faculty appointments are defined by contract and policies S10-7 and S15-
30 6, therefore be it
