SUBJECT Policy for Review: S73-24 Computing The GPA For "CR" Grades Given In Graduate Courses

**History/Description of this item:**

In the course of O&G's review of senate policies during Fall 2017, we encountered S73-24, which sets guidelines for calculating GPAs for graduate students receiving grades of "Credit." This seems to be more or less in line with current practices, but given numerous shifts in grading policies over the years (see for example, F88-6, which seems to clarify or replace, in its discussion of thesis grades CR/NC); and then is further clarified by S99-6. It appears that S99-6 might replace both S73-24 and F88-6. Finally, for undergraduates, S11-5 amends to clarify for ENGL1A & 1B for undergraduates.
