ACADEMIC COUNCIL POLICY RECOMMENDATION #F66-6

At its meeting of November 7, 1966, the Academic Council adopted the following policy statement on the rights of faculty members on leave to participate in departmental affairs. This statement was presented by the Faculty and Staff Affairs Committee.

Unless otherwise determined by the department, all department members who would be entitled to participate in departmental proceedings if not on leave, may so participate and vote, even though on leave, if they participate and vote in person. Because of the importance of deliberation in resolving conflicts and determining policy, absentee and proxy voting shall be allowed only by specific departmental rule.

"Leave" includes leave in residence, leave with pay (sabbatical), research leave, and leave without pay.

For the purpose of making any rule either restricting or enlarging the right to participate or vote of persons on leave, the department shall consist of all department faculty who are part of the faculty electorate as defined in Article II, Section 4, of the Faculty Constitution. All such rules shall, of course, be consistent with other established College policies.
