ACADEMIC COUNCIL POLICY RECOMMENDATION #F70-2

At its meeting of September 14, 1970, the Academic Council approved the following amendments to Policy #F68-28, Liaison Committee formation, as introduced by Richard Elliott, Chairman of Committee on Committees.

Amendments to Policy, #F68-28, Liaison Committee

The Executive Committee of the San Jose State College Academic Council recommends the establishment of an Academic Council Liaison Committee on Problems and Issues at San Jose State College.

The charge to this committee is to seek out, isolate, and clarify urgent problems and issues of concern to the faculty and students of this college and seek to bring about speedy resolutions of these matters. When such problems normally fall within the province of one of the policy committees, the President, the Chairman of the Academic Council, the Executive Committee, or the Academic Council shall determine the referral of the problem. The committee is to serve as a hearing body for faculty, student, and administrative group representatives, and is first to seek to achieve in consultation with the President resolution of the problems and issues within this institution. Problems and issues that cannot be resolved locally shall be taken by this committee, acting on the instructions of the Academic Council, and in consultation with the President, to any relevant agency, such as the Statewide Academic Senate, the Chancellor's Office, the Board of Trustees, and the Legislature.

This committee, as a standing policy committee of the Academic Council, will report to the Academic Council, and will receive such instructions as the Council considers appropriate.

Membership shall be chosen, no later than the second Council meeting each Fall, by the Academic Council upon the recommendation of the Committee on Committees.

The first committee shall be chosen immediately upon acceptance of this resolution.
