ACADEMIC COUNCIL POLICY RECOMMENDATION #F71-2

At its meeting of October 18, 1971, the Academic Council approved the following resolution as presented by Dr. John Galm, Chairman of the Professional Standards Committee.

- WHEREAS, The Academic Council is a policy formulating body and thus responsible for administrative functions within the College; and
- WHEREAS, The Academic Senate serves a similar function for the State Colleges; therefore be it
- RESOLVED That administrative time be assigned to the Chairman of the San Jose State College Academic Council and the Academic Senators from San Jose State College and, be it further
- RESOLVED That the priority of the assignment of administrative time be the following: first priority shall be one-quarter time for the Chairman of the Academic Council; second priority shall be one-quarter time for each of the Academic Senators; third priority shall be an additional one-quarter time for the Chairman of the Academic Council.
