ACADEMIC COUNCIL POLICY RECOMMENDATION

At its meeting of November 6, 1972, the Academic Council passed the following change in By-Law 1.8, as presented by Paul Brown on behalf of the Executive Committee at the Academic Council meeting of October 16, 1972.

Change in By-Law 1.8:

"The elected student members on the Academic Council shall be chosen by the Associated Students in the same manner as student officers are elected. Those candidates-not-elected-but-who-receive-not-less-than-ten-percent-of-the-votes east-in-the-Associated-Students-election-shall-be-alternates-who-will-succeed to-vacancies-in-the-order-of-number-of-votes-received. If a vacancy occurs, the Associated Students President shall fill the vacancy by appointment with a 2/3 majority approval of the student council members present. Students shall be elected for a term of one year. No student who is an elected officer of the Associated Students shall serve concurrently as a student-at-large representative on the Academic Council."
