STUDENT HONORS

- WHEREAS The recognition of honors is a tradition in the academy, and
- WHEREAS No visual expression of student honors now exists during the annual Commencement exercise; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED That those who graduate with distinction or great distinction be authorized to wear a symbol on academic regalia, and be it further
- RESOLVED That an appropriate symbol in University colors be authorized, the final form of which is to be chosen by the Financial and Student Affairs Committee.
