Dear Ravisha,

I'm writing on behalf of President Papazian to communicate her decision not to sign the following two policies: S19-4 Qualifications for Student Office Holders and S19-5 The Use and Abuse of Alcohol and Other Drugs, despite their strong content since the responsibility for these policies lies in Student Affairs and not with the Academic Senate. She will ask that Student Affairs follow-up on updating their policies in both of these areas, taking into account the thoughtful input of the Academic Senate.

S19-4 Qualifications for Student Office Holders

The President will ask Patrick Day, Vice President for Student Affairs to review S19-4 Qualifications for Student Office Holders with stakeholders in Student Affairs. The policy may provide valuable input for his division, as it looks to update its policies and the Student Handbook.

S19-5 The Use and Abuse of Alcohol and Other Drugs

This policy is intended to rescind F10-1, which the President indicates should be rescinded because it usurps her authority. Like with S19-4, she will ask Patrick Day to review the content with stakeholders in Student Affairs, and will delegate to him the responsibility to develop a policy to be included in the Student Handbook.
