ACADEMIC COUNCIL POLICY RECOMMENDATION

#S66-7

At its meeting of April 25 the Academic Council adopted the following policy concerning student honors, said policy developed by the Curriculum and Instruction Committee:

Resolved: That it shall become the policy of the college effective immediately that those students who achieve during their final semester grade point averages entitling them to graduation with honors shall have such honors indicated upon their diplomas of graduation by rubber stamp (or some such means) and duly entered upon their personnel records even though it is not possible to indicate such honors in the graduation program.
