

ACADEMIC COUNCIL POLICY RECOMMENDATION #S73-10

At its meeting of March 12, 1973, the Academic Council passed the following policy as presented by Dr. Theodore Norton, Chairman of the Curriculum Committee.

ADMISSION OF DISQUALIFIED STUDENTS TO EXTENSION COURSES

RESOLVED, That disqualified students may enroll in extension courses, but are not eligible for concurrent enrollment in regular courses or for external degree programs; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the University, in considering applications for readmission and reinstatement, shall not be required to accept 400 - series extension course credits as evidence of the student's qualification for reinstatement.
