ADDENDUM TO GRADING POLICY

S 73-23

WHEREAS, The California Educational Code requires that a Master's degree approved program must contain a minimum of 30 semester units, and

WHEREAS, A grade point average of 3.0(B) or better must be maintained in completing a Master's degree program; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That at least 60% of courses on Master's degree program shall be courses in which letter grades are assigned.
