

S90-2 UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION RESEARCH GRANTS

Legislative History:

Supersedes S74-11.

At its meeting of February 19, 1990, the Academic Senate approved the following Policy Recommendation presented by Sandra Kajiwara for the Curriculum and Research Committee.

ACTION BY THE UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT:

"Approved and Accepted as University Policy, Effective immediately." Signed Gail Fullerton, 2/22/90.

Whereas, The San Jose State University Foundation makes available funds to support faculty and student research (UFRG) based on a school allocation formula approved by the Foundation Board of Trustees, and

Whereas, The Foundation Board of Trustees has stated that these funds shall be used for the specific purpose of stimulating research and other creative activity that could lead to the development of a larger grant application submitted to an outside source (Foundation Resolution 96, approved March 30, 1989), and

Whereas, The Foundation Board of Trustees has designated the Associate Academic Vice President for Graduate Studies and Research (AAVP/GS&R) as the university official responsible for administration of these funds, be it therefore

Resolved, That each school shall file with the AAVP/GS&R a written policy governing the allocation of these UFRG funds and that the school policy shall be consistent with the Foundation guidelines for UFRG awards, and

Resolved, That each school shall submit to the AAVP/GS&R an annual report of awards indicating how the awards were used to develop larger grant applications, and

Resolved, That unused funds from each year's allocation shall be returned to the AAVP/GS&R for

reallocation consistent with the Foundation guidelines for UFRG awards.
