Rationale:

This committee, listed under the "Other" designation of Senate committees, is an administrative committee charged with the review of academic disqualifications and academic reinstatement petitions. Membership of the

The proposed description will provide an update of titles, as well as expand membership to include EOP and Counseling Services representation as currently listed. As committee appointments have not been made by the Provost, this statement should be deleted.

Should revision to the committee name be approved, all references to “Admissions and Standards Committee” in this document would be modified to reflect that change.
