At its meeting of March 1, 1993, the Academic Senate approved the following Senate Management Resolution presented by Theodore Norton for the Organization and Government Committee.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Resolved,

That the following be added to the Standing Rules of the Senate as Rule 16:

16. The Executive Committee may place a discussion item on the Senate agenda (under New Business) at its own initiative or at the request of a policy committee or at the request of any six members. A brief written statement of the topic and its current relevance shall be distributed to Senate members at or in advance of the meeting. A spokesperson shall be designated by the group requesting the discussion, and the spokesperson shall be recognized by the Chair to open the discussion. The only permissible Senate action on a discussion item at that meeting is that the discussion be carried over to a subsequent meeting or reference to committee.
