At its meeting of March 4, 1996, the Academic Senate approved the following Senate Management Resolution presented by Chris Jochim for the Organization and Government Committee.

**SENATE MANAGEMENT RESOLUTION****SENATE COMMITTEE REDUCTIONS**

- Whereas, Most of the business previously done by the Planning, Safety, and Finance Committee is being done by other campus bodies, in particular, the Campus Planning Board and the Budget Advisory Committee; and
- Whereas, The two operating committees that report to the Planning, Safety and Finance Committee -- the Public Safety Committee and the Campus Ecology and Landscape Committee -- should be abolished. (The Public Safety Committee recommended its own dissolution in its AY 1994-95 annual report. The functions of the Campus Ecology and Landscape Committee should be transferred to the Campus Planning Board.) Therefore be it
- Resolved, That the Planning, Safety, and Finance Committee be abolished effective at the end of AY 1995-96; and be it further
- Resolved, That the Public Safety Committee and the Campus Ecology and Landscape Committee be abolished effective at the end of AY 1995-96; and be it further
- Resolved, That the Organization and Government Committee shall draft a resolution to amend S91-7 (Campus Planning Board) to add to the Campus Planning Board a faculty member from Biological Sciences and to state the functions being transferred to the Board from the Campus Ecology and Landscape Committee.
