SFC Business Completed 2010/2011

The Student Fairness Committee (SFC) met 10 times during the 2010/2011 academic year (AY); 4 meetings in the fall semester and 6 meetings in the spring semester. The agendas and minutes summarizing the case dispositions are included with this report.

The number of students seeking assistance from the University Ombudsperson during AY 2010/2011 was 271. The SFC investigated 6 new cases and there was no case forwarded to BAFPR for investigation.

Student Fairness Case Detail

0111-001 Grade Dispute/College of Social Science: Political Science

Found in favor of the student.

SFC recommended that the student's grade be changed form a C- to a C since the greensheet did not indicate a plus and minus scale range, only whole grades.

0111-002 Grade Dispute/College of Social Science: History

Case was resolved informally in favor of the student after assignment to a subcommittee. Grade was changed from an F to a D-.

0111-004 Grade Dispute/College of Humanities and the Arts: English

Found in favor of the instructor regarding the grade.

SFC recommended that the department consider placing more importance on in class essays versus out of class essays to help balance the weight of the assignments so it does not result in an automatic "F" in the course.

0111-005 Grade Dispute/College of Humanities and the Arts: English

Found in favor of the student.

SFC recommended that the student be granted a retroactive withdrawal based on the fact that the student was not provided due process of a hearing and was removed from class without the basis for legitimate reason evidenced by the findings in the Student Conduct report.

0111-006 Grade Dispute/College of Humanities and the Arts: Music and Dance

Found in favor of the instructor regarding the grade.

SFC recommends the course greensheet be modified removing all references to attendance in relation to grading and indicate how participation will be assessed should this be a part of the grading criteria.

0111-007 Grade Dispute /College of Engineering: Computer Engineering

Found in favor of the student.

SFC recommended the student receive a retroactive withdrawal and a full refund for the course. SFC recommended that the instructor provide a grading rubric for both the syllabus and individual assignments that explains the point distribution and to provide timely, concise, and substantive feedback on student work when requested.
