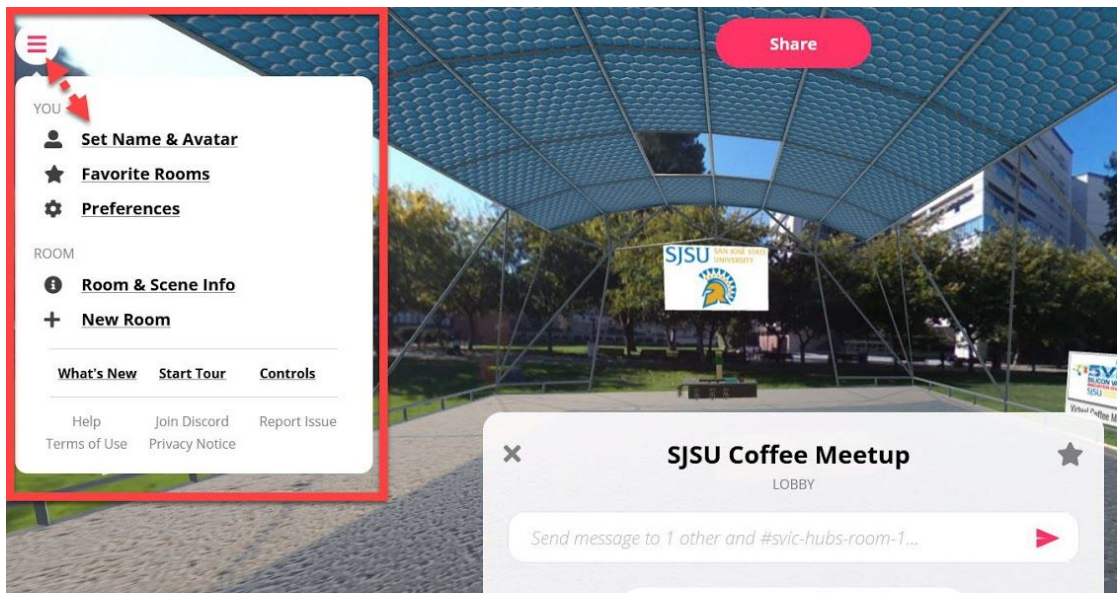
Networking Session Instructions

SVIC: Virtual Room Tutorial

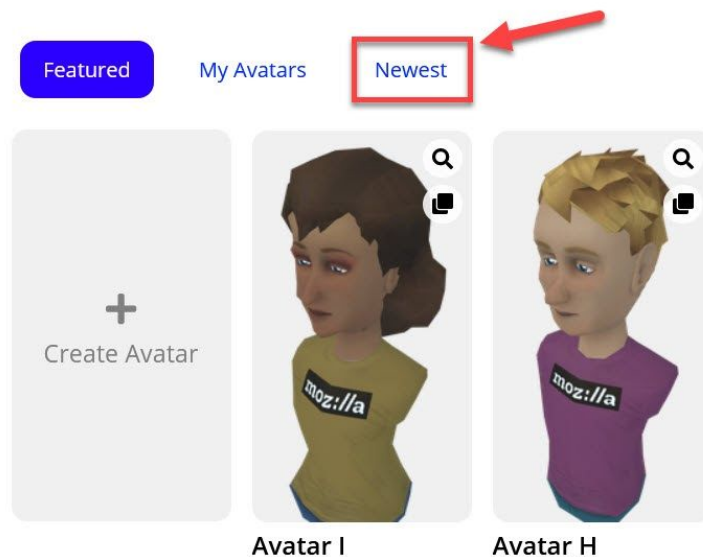
Each team has their own [virtual room](#) so conference attendees can drop in and visit you. Take turns one at a time to go visit another team if you want, but *please ensure there are always at least two team members in the room for the full hour of networking.*

(This [2 minute video](#) shows the same basic process as below. (NOTE: Some features, like object creation are disabled in these rooms.)

1. Use hamburger menu on the upper left to set your name & avatar.



2. Click **Browse Avatars**, and then click on the **Choose Newest** tab.



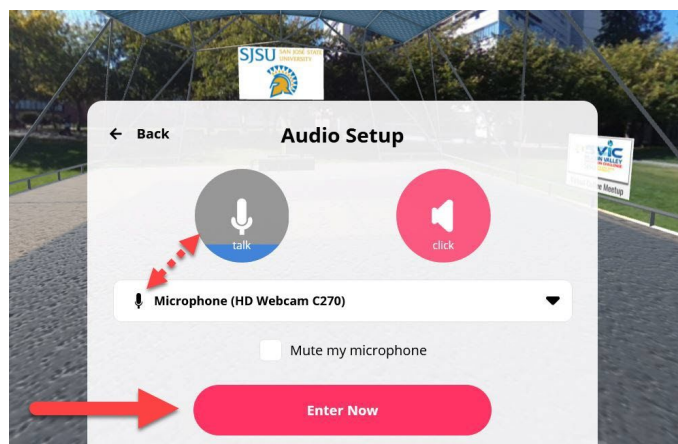
3. **Please browse to page 3 and choose an avatar!**

4. **Click to enter room.**

(Room capacity is limited to 24 avatars, but up to 100 additional people can participate from the lobby where they can watch, hear, and text chat with avatars actually *in* the room.)

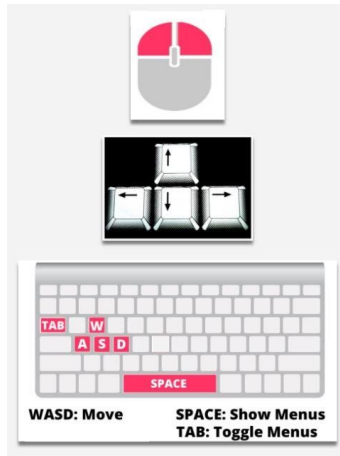


5. **Check Your Mic & Audio are Enabled, then Click Enter Now.** Use text chat if you ever have trouble with your mic. NOTE: Audio in Hubs is *spatial*, which means the further away from people you move, the more faint their voices become. Stay close and face the person you are speaking to.



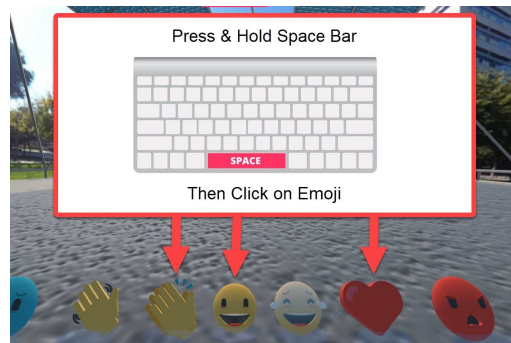
6. **Navigate the room with Mouse & Keyboard Keys.**

Left click and drag on the screen to turn and look all around. Then use the arrow keys (or WASD) to move forward and back, and side to side in the room.

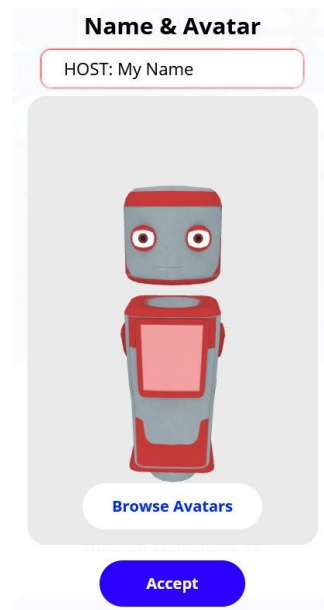


7. Press the Spacebar for Emoticons.

This is a quick way to share non-verbal feedback when others are speaking.



Room hosts will be popping in and out of each room periodically in case guests have questions or want a link to go to another room. Look for a Red Robot with the word HOST next to their name.

TroubleShooting

This is pretty powerful technology considering it's all running in a browser and nobody has to download anything. That said, here's a few tips:

- **Computer Lag or Frozen Screen?** *If you freeze up, refresh your browser or just close your browser and try re-entering the room.* It is possible to experience lag time or performance issues, depending upon a lot of factors. (For example, what device people are on, how much content is in the room, how many people are moving around and talking etc.)
- **Computer access is *generally* better than on a mobile device.** This is just a very general rule of thumb. It's not meant to say that you can't access Hubs rooms on a phone, you can!
- **Remember, spatial audio.** If someone is too far away or has their back turned to you, it may be harder to hear them. Stay closer and face people when talking to them. Use the chat feature if anyone has mic trouble.

Have fun and embrace the spirit of playful adventure! This is especially helpful when it comes to new or beta technologies, like browser-based VR.
